RESOLUTION AMENDING THE ELECTED OFFICIAL OUT-OF-STATE
TRAVEL POLICY.

BY PRESIDENT ANDERSON:

RESOLVED, that the city of Duluth elected official out-of-state travel policy, adopted by Resolution 10-0179, is hereby amended by striking the first sentence of Paragraph 1 and replacing it with the following:

"The out-of-state event, workshop, conference or assignment must be approved in advance by the chief administrative officer for out-of-state travel by the mayor, the council president for out-of-state travel by city councilors and by the council vice president for out-of-state travel by the council president, except that international travel by city councilors must be approved in advance by the city council at an open meeting. Decisions regarding out-of-state travel may be appealed to the entire city council. Approval of council travel will be recorded on the council agenda under "Presentation of Petitions and Other Communications."
