RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN PUBLIC PLACES ON HARBOR DRIVE ON JULY 28-AUGUST 2, 2010, IN CONJUNCTION WITH TALL SHIPS DULUTH 2010 AND SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

CITY PROPOSAL:

BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 8-22(b) of the Duluth City Code, the Duluth City Council hereby authorizes consumption of alcoholic beverages in public places on Harbor Drive on July 28 - August 2, 2010, in the area shown on Public Document No. _____ to coincide with Visit Duluth's special events license for Tall Ships Duluth 2010, provided that all alcoholic beverages consumed outside of the designated serving areas of licensed establishments be consumed only from paper or plastic cups.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the dates of this authority may be amended, in the case of inclement weather, if requested in writing by the licensee and approved by the administration.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution waives the drinking in public prohibition on Harbor Drive behind the DECC in conjunction with the Tall Ships Duluth 2010. Such waiver for special events is authorized by Section 8-22(b) of the City Code and is requested by the police department after consultation with Visit Duluth to eliminate the law enforcement problem of having to take action against persons wandering beyond the designated service areas with drinks. For safety purposes, all alcoholic beverages consumed in these areas will have to be in paper cups.
