RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO RICE LAKE CONSTRUCTION GROUP FOR THE EAST INTERCEPTOR SANITARY SEWER OVERFLOW STORAGE FACILITY, PHASE 2, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,626,107.

RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Rice Lake Construction Group for the east interceptor sanitary sewer overflow storage facility, Phase 2, in the amount of \$11,626,107, with \$4,000,000 funded by a WIF grant and the remaining \$7,626,107 payable from the Clean Water Fund 532, Department/Agency 500, Object 5532, City Project No. 0519SN.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution will authorize the construction of the East interceptor sanitary sewer overflow storage facility, Phase 2, by Rice Lake Construction Group in the amount of \$11,626,107. \$4,000,000 of the costs will be funded by a WIF grant, and the remaining \$7,626,107 will be payable from Clean Water Fund 0532, Department/Agency 500, Object 5532, City Project No. 0519SN, Requisition No. 10-0272. Rice Lake Construction Group was the lowest bidder of the seven companies that submitted bids, and the bid is 15 percent lower than the engineer's estimate of \$13,368,000.
