Clint Deraas was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Deraas explained that they have been operating the food and beverage operation at the airport for the last four years. He reviewed that the airport's insurance has been covering their operation, and the airport director has told them they need to operate under their own insurance. Mr. Deraas also stated that they will continue operating the food and beverage service when the new terminal is completed. Officer Vang stated he has approved this application.
