STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: In February 2010, the city council authorized allocating \$12,700 to assist the Great Lakes Aquarium with state mandated upgrades and repairs to its escalator in order to be in compliance with current state code. Once the repair had been made, the state inspector would not certify the escalator until additional work had been completed. The aquarium has requested the city assist with the total cost by allocating an additional \$6,800. This resolution authorizes the proper city officials to allocate \$6,800 from the reserve for capital improvements fund balance in the tourism fund to aid the aquarium.
