STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution will authorize a consultant agreement with SEH, Inc. for professional engineering services related to the Lakewalk East extension, phases IV and V, from 60th Avenue East to Brighton Beach for an estimated amount of \$46,000, payable from the capital improvement fund. This study will explore route options for crossing the Lester River and Highway 61, and the costs associated with each route. Construction of these phases is scheduled for 2012 and will be funded by a federal transportation grant and city C.I.P funds. This phase of engineering services are estimated at \$46,900.
