Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion of 6/2/2010: Mr. Bronson was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Bronson reviewed that this application is conjunction with the Tall Ships that will be in the Duluth harbor for four days, and because there will be eight ships in the harbor, huge crowds are expected in Canal Park. He went to explain that they would like to be able serve as many people as possible and would like to put tables and chairs on the sidewalk bricks in front of the deck as they are doing for the marathon. Mr. Bronson further stated that there will be a special events license applied for to allow the area to be enclosed on the bricks where 12 tables and chairs will be set up. To questioning from the commission, Mr. Bronson replied they would like to serve in the expanded area all day through the evening. Mr. Bronson stated that this is a family event and questioned the need to have security present during all hours of the expansion. Attorney Lutterman replied that security requirements are determined by the police department and he would have to talk to the police chief about that issue. There being no further discussion, Mr. Wright moved THAT THE APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY EXPANSION OF THE ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JULY 29-31, 2010, BE APPROVED, CONTINGENT ON AN APPROVED SPECIAL EVENTS LICENSE AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL. Mr. Pekkala seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
