RESOLUTION GOVERNING THE SEASONAL DEER HUNT IN DULUTH BY  
MODIFYING THE BOUNDARIES OF CERTAIN DESIGNATED HUNTING  
AREAS AND DESIGNATING CERTAIN HOT SPOTS AVAILABLE FOR  
HUNTING DURING THE 2010 SEASON ONLY.

CITY PROPOSAL:

WHEREAS, the Arrowhead Bowhunters Alliance (ABA) is the contract agent for the 2010 seasonal deer hunt; and

WHEREAS, the ABA has requested boundary modifications to some of the current designated hunting areas; and

WHEREAS, the ABA has also received complaints from city residents regarding deer damaging property in areas located outside of the current designated hunting areas; and

WHEREAS, the ABA has identified these areas and is requesting they be designated as being in special need of deer removal, or hot spots, for the 2010 season.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 6-77(d)(1) of the Duluth City Code, the city council hereby designates the areas depicted with yellow outline on maps 1 - 15 of Public Document No. \_\_\_\_\_ on file in the office of the city clerk, as areas in special need of deer removal, or hot spots, and are hereby made available for deer harvesting during the 2010 seasonal hunt.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that those boundary changes denoted by blue cross hatching within the designating hunting areas as outlined in red, as shown on

maps 1- 15 of Public Document No. \_\_\_\_\_ on file in the office of the city clerk, are hereby approved.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution designates certain areas within the City as areas in need of special deer removal, or hot spots, where deer harvesting shall be allowed during the 2010 seasonal hunt. This resolution also makes permanent boundary changes to some designated hunting areas. These areas are designated based on resident complaints.

Any hunts conducted shall only be made with the permission of and in cooperation with neighborhood residents and in consultation with the Duluth Police department and the city hunt representative.
