Alcohol, gambling, and tobacco commission discussion of 6/2/2010: John Vaydich was present on behalf of the applications. Mr. Vaydich explained that applicants for a temporary 3.2 percent malt liquor license need to have non profit status with the State, and because DSPA is a non profit organization with the State, they have been asked to apply for the for the tournaments at Wheeler Field. He explained that the tournament being held July 17 and 18 is the Copasetic tournament that has been held for over 30 years, and that the beer will be sold out of the building built by DSPA for food and beverages and has contracted with a private security company to work during the tournament. Mr. Vaydich stated that the application for August 7 and 8 is for the Beerhunters tournament which has also been held for over 30 years and the same procedures will be done for this tournament also. Officer Vang stated there have been no problems in the past with these tournaments and have approved the applications. There being no further discussion, Mr. moved that THE APPLICATIONS OF DULUTH SOFTBALL PLAYER'S ASSOCIATION, INC., WHEELER FIELD, FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE 3.2 PERCENT MALT LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JULY 17 AND 18, 2010 AND AUGUST 7 AND 8, 2010, WITH JOHN VAYDICH, MANAGER, BE APPROVED AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL.
