RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO RICE LAKE CONSTRUCTION GROUP FOR THE EAST INTERCEPTOR SANITARY SEWER OVERFLOW STORAGE FACILITY, PHASE 3, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,883,000.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Rice Lake Construction Group for construction of the east interceptor sanitary sewer overflow storage facility, Phase 3, diversion structure, storage facility landscaping, maintenance garage and restroom facility, for the engineering division in accordance with its low specification bid of \$6,883,000. \$4,000,000 will be funded by a WIF grant and the remaining \$2,883,000 will be paid from Clean Water Fund 532, Department/Agency 500, Object 5532, City Project No. 0891SN.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution will authorize the construction of the east interceptor sanitary sewer overflow storage facility, Phase 3, by Rice Lake Construction Group in the amount of \$6,883,000, with the costs to be funded by a \$4,000,000 WIF grant and \$2,883,000 from the Clean Water Fund 532, Department/Agency 500, Object 5532, City Project No. 0891SN, Requisition No. 10-0299. Rice Lake Construction Group was the only bidder. Although the bid was 22 percent higher than the engineer's estimate of \$5,618,000, we recommend award because of the city's consent decree requirements to eliminate sanitary sewer overflows, and prices are not expected to be lower if the project is rebid.
