RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING NO PARKING FROM 3 A.M. TO 6 A.M.
ON STREETS IN DOWNTOWN DULUTH.

BY COUNCILOR FEDORA:

RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-94 of the Duluth City Code, 1959, as amended, the following no parking 2 a.m. to 6 a.m. zones will be changed to no parking 3 a.m. to 6 a.m.:

~~Sixth Avenue West: Superior Street to Second Street (east side only);~~

~~Fifth Avenue West: Superior Street to First Street (both sides);~~

~~Fourth Avenue West: Michigan Street to First Street (both sides);~~

~~Third Avenue West: Michigan Street to Second Street (both sides);~~

~~Second Avenue West: Michigan Street to Second Street (both sides);~~

~~First Avenue West: Michigan Street to Second Street (both sides);~~

~~First Avenue East: Michigan Street to Second Street (both sides);~~

~~Second Avenue East: Michigan Street to Second Street (both sides);~~

~~Third Avenue East: Michigan Street to Second Street (both sides);~~

~~Fourth Avenue East: Superior Street to Second Street (east side only);~~

~~Michigan Street: Sixth Avenue West to Fourth Avenue East;~~

Superior Street: Third ~~Sixth~~ Avenue West to Fourth ~~Tenth~~ Avenue East
(both sides);

First Street: Fourth ~~Sixth~~ Avenue West to Second ~~Third~~ Avenue East
(both sides);

Fourth Street: Fifth Avenue East to Sixth Avenue East (both sides)

~~First Street: Third Avenue East to Tenth Avenue East (south side only);~~

~~Canal Park Drive: Railroad Street to Buchanan Street (west side only);~~

~~Lake Avenue: Aerial Lift Bridge to Sutphin Street (both sides);~~

~~Priley Drive (meters only).~~

FURTHER RESOLVED, that these restrictions shall apply to where there is legal parking only and that the zone changes shall take effect upon the installation of signs indicating the new time limits.

Resolution 10-0362, as amended, was unanimously adopted.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: As bars can now remain open until 2 a.m., this change will allow Downtown bar employees to finish their shifts and return to their vehicles without parking illegally. The city council may, at a later date, want to look into extending this schedule city wide after further input from staff.
