RESOLUTION AMENDING CONTRACT 19919 WITH MSA PROFESSIONAL SERVICES, INC., FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR DESIGN, BIDDING AND CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE REHABILITATION/RECONSTRUCTION OF SANITARY SEWER LIFT STATIONS, INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$24,115.54 FOR A NEW TOTAL OF \$187,212.54.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: By Resolution 05-0475 (Contract No. 19919), passed on July 11, 2005, MSA Professional Services, Inc., was authorized to design, prepare plans and specifications, bid and provide construction engineering services to rehabilitate/reconstruct five sanitary sewer lift stations (Nos. 2, 7, 21, 29 and 38). This resolution will amend Contract 19919 by \$24,115.51 for a new project total of \$187,212.54. The additional fees are due to changes in scope for design and construction related services, including additional bid package, implementation of fall protection equipment, time associated with two equipment start-ups, replacement of storm sewer, and replacement of collapsed sanitary sewer. The increase is distributed as follows: Lift Station No. 29 (City Project No. 0170SN), \$4,106.46; Lift Station No. 38 (City Project No. 0086SN), \$4,106.46; and Lift Station No. 2 (City Project No. 0085SN), \$15,902.62. The increase will be payable from Sanitary Sewer Fund 0530, Department/Agency 500, Organization 1905, Object 5536.
