RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A PARKING METER ZONE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF ST. MARIE STREET BETWEEN UNIVERSITY DRIVE AND MAPLEWOOD COURT.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-108 of the Duluth City Code, 1959, as amended, the following parking meter zone is hereby established:

On the south side of St. Marie Street between University Drive and Maplewood Court.

Proposed rate will be one dollar for one hour, with a four hour limit.

The metered zone will consist of approximately 40 parking meters.

Metered parking shall be applicable between 8:30 AM and 5:30 PM, Monday through Saturday.

This metered zone will take effect upon installation of the parking meters.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution establishes an on street parking meter zone and establishes parking rates and hours therefor. This zone will create a turnover of parking spaces for students at UMD. The proposed meters will accept credit or debit cards or quarters. The meters will be installed on the outside of the sidewalk to facilitate snow removal. This proposal was reviewed and recommended by the city's parking commission on June 8, 2010. UMD is not in favor of the meter installation.
