The proper city officials are authorized to execute and implement an agreement with the union to provide for employing one or more unit members consistent with this resolution.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This classification was created as a new entry position into the water plant series to attract more applicants and provide additional workforce development opportunities for city employees. The requirements for the classification are lower than water plant operator C including a lower state license and less experience. The pay range negotiated for the classification is Range 24, \$2,930 to \$3,438 per month.
