STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes an agreement with the United States Marshals Service (USMS) by which the city will participate in a regional fugitive task force. The primary mission of the task force is to investigate and arrest, as part of joint law enforcement operations, persons who have active state and federal warrants for their arrest. Targeted crimes will primarily include violent crimes against persons, weapons offenses, felony drug offenses, failure to register as a sex offender, and crimes committed by subjects who have a criminal history involving felony crimes, felony drug offenses and weapons offenses.
