STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This \$127,876 will be added to the 2010 CDBG project for sidewalk accessibility and curb ramps, which is working to complete the portion of West Superior Street from 19th to 22nd avenues West. The West Superior Street project, in the Lincoln Park Business District, was originally funded with a portion of the ARRA (American Recovery Reinvestment Act) funds and was to be continued with both FY 2010 and FY 2011 CDBG funding. The city is required to expend these funds by September 30, 2012.
