RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH INFRATECH, INFRASTRUCTURE TECHNOLOGIES, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO CCTV (CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISION) FORD E-350 TRUCKS WITH IBAK RAPIDVIEW CAMERA EQUIPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$387,757.38.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to contract with Infratech, Infrastructure Technologies, Inc., for the purchase and delivery of two CCTV (closed circuit television) Ford E-350 commercial cutaway van trucks with Ibak RapidView camera equipment in accordance with Minnesota State Contract No. 443418, Release S-986(5), specifications and pricing in the amount of \$376,580, less \$14,000 for trade-ins plus \$24,927.38 sales tax plus \$250 for license, registration, and title fees, for a combined total amount of \$387,757.38, terms net 30, FOB destination, payable from Sewer Fund 530, Department/Agency 500, Organization 1905, Object 5580.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes the purchase of two CCTV (closed circuit television) Ford E-350 trucks with Ibak camera equipment from Infratech, Infrastructure Technologies, Inc. for \$387,757.38, payable from the sewer fund. These trucks will replace units 2793 and 2890.

This purchase is based on Minnesota State Contract 443418, Release S-986(5). Both trucks will be used for inspecting and televising sanitary sewer and stormwater pipelines. This is part of a critical pipeline maintenance schedule that is required by the EPA consent decree. (The Western Lake Superior Sanitary District and the city of Duluth are subject to a consent decree with the environmental protection agency and the Minnesota pollution control agency to eliminate sanitary sewer overflows to Lake Superior by 2016.)

Infratech, Infrastructure Technologies, Inc., is located in Rogers, Minnesota.
