Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion of 9/1/2010: Carrie Emslander was present on behalf of the application. Ms. Emslander explained that this is their third annual tailgating party being held in the parking lot at the school prior to the football game as part of the alumni weekend. She continued that they were unaware that a permit was needed for this event as they will not be charging for the beer but will be charging for the food at the event. To questioning from the commission, Ms. Emslander replied that they will be using a wrist band system they have used in the past to identify students 21 and over, and will also limit each individual to three beers. To further questioning, Ms. Emslander replied that they will be hiring two off duty police officers for the event. Officer Vang stated that they agreed upon security for the event.
