
RESOLUTION APPROVING ISSUANCE OF A TEMPORARY ON SALE

Mr. Hanke explained that Minnesota Ballet is holding their fifth annual Celebrity Dance Challenge at Marshall School and would like to be able to serve alcohol at the event. He stated in the past they have used a caterer for the event to supply the food and alcohol, but this year they will be serving the alcohol for the event. Mr. Hanke continued saying that he has contacted the police department and they will be hiring two off duty police officers to work at the event. Officer Vang stated he has approved this application. The clerk noted that they are requesting to amend their serving time on the application. There being no further discussion, Mr. Birchland moved that the amended application of MINNESOTA BALLET, (CELEBRITY DANCE CHALLENGE), 1215 RICE LAKE ROAD FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR FEBRUARY 10, 2011, WITH WILLY MCMANUS, MANAGER, BE APPROVED, AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL.
