

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT IN YEAR 2010 WITH ST. LOUIS COUNTY FOR FOUR QUARTERS OF SHIELD MAINTENANCE SOFTWARE ASSOCIATED WITH NEMESIS (NORTHEASTERN MINNESOTA ENFORCEMENT AND SAFETY INFORMATION SYSTEM) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$66,975.00.

RESOLVED, that city officials are hereby authorized to execute an agreement in year 2010 with St. Louis County for four quarters of shield maintenance software associated with NEMESIS (Northeastern Minnesota Enforcement and Safety Information System) in the amount of \$66,975.00, terms net 30, payable from General Fund 110, Dept./Agency 160, Org. 1610, Object 5404.





STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes an agreement in year 2010 with St. Louis County for four quarters of shield maintenance software associated with NEMESIS (Northeastern Minnesota Enforcement and Safety Information System) in the amount of \$66,975, payable from the general fund.

NEMESIS is designed to provide shared integrated resources for public safety agencies to track information regarding people, incidents, and cases throughout the criminal justice system. It connects local and statewide criminal and court systems to strengthen public safety in Minnesota.

Two separate requisitions totaling \$66,975.00 were issued in year 2010. The city purchasing division issued a purchase order to the St. Louis County sheriff for the first requisition (10-0320) on June 4, 2010, for \$33,487.50 covering the

first two quarters. (The city council was not required to authorize this amount under \$50,000.) The county now requires all payments to be made to the St. Louis County auditor. As a result, the Duluth police department prepared a second separate requisition for the county auditor (10-0539) for the last two quarters of year 2010. The purchasing division will issue a second purchase order after council approval.
