RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 10-0546, INCREASING THE CONTRACT WITH MORTON SALT, INC., BY \$322,003.69 FOR JANUARY THROUGH APRIL 2011.


CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that Resolution 10-0546R is hereby amended, authorizing city officials to contract with Morton Salt, Inc., for the purchase and delivery of an additional 5,500 tons of road salt for January through April 2011 in accordance with Minnesota State Contract No. 443277, Release S-803(5) specifications and pricing at \$54.78 per ton for \$301,290.00 plus sales tax of \$20,713.69 for a total amount of \$322,003.69, terms net 30, FOB destination and payable from General Fund 110, Dept./Agency 121 (Public Administration), Org. 1217-2140, Object 5223-01.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes an increase to the city's contract with Morton Salt, Inc., an additional 5,500 tons of road salt for the 2011 season (January through April), for \$322,003.69, payable from the general fund. The purchase is based on State Contract No. 443277, Release S-803(5). Salt is used during the winter season to de-ice roads for the prevention of accidents.

The council previously approved Resolution 10-0546 which authorized 4,500 tons of road salt for January through April 2011. However, that estimate was based on the assumption of a mild winter. The street maintenance division has already used up its budget for this harsh season.

Morton Salt, Inc., is headquartered in Chicago, Illinois.
