

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution will authorize cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) rehabilitation of sanitary sewers at various locations by Insituform Technologies USA, Inc. in the amount of \$485,806.70, with \$383,106.30 payable from Sanitary Sewer Fund 530, and \$102,700.40 payable from Stormwater Utility Fund 35, Department 500, Division 1905, Object 5533, city project 0892SN, requisition no. 11-0345. Insituform Technologies USA, Inc. was the lowest bidder of the three companies that responded. Although their bid is 8.3 per cent higher than the engineer's estimate of \$448,720, we recommend award. Insituform Technologies has performed very well on the last four sanitary sewer lining projects, and lower prices are not expected if this project is rebid.
