Alcohol, Gambling and Tobacco Commission discussion: 6/1/11 Tim Allen was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Allen explained that currently the State law allows a bed and breakfast to serve two glasses of wine per guest each day. He continued saying that they would like to be able to sell a bottle of wine or champagne to their guests and this license would allow them to do so. To questioning from the commission, Ms. Lutterman reviewed State law and stated this application was allowed by the city. Officer Vang replied he has approved this application. There being no further discussion, Mr. Birchland moved THAT THE APPLICATION OF A. G. THOMSON HOUSE HISTORIC BED AND BREAKFAST INN, LLC , (A G THOMSON HOUSE), 2617 EAST THIRD STREET, FOR A BED AND BREAKFAST WINE LICENSE FOR THE PERIOD ENDING AUGUST 31, 2011, BE APPROVED, AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL.
