RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH BEDROCK FLINT, INC., FOR TUCKPOINTING AT VARIOUS ZOO LOCATIONS, THEREBY INCREASING THE ORIGINAL PURCHASE ORDER AMOUNT BY \$190,882, FOR A NEW CONTRACT TOTAL OF \$234,647.

CITY PROPOSAL:


RESOLVED, that city officials are hereby authorized to contract with Bedrock Flint, Inc., for tuckpointing at various zoo locations in accordance with city-approved specifications and the vendor's prior bid, thereby increasing the original purchase order 10-0479 by \$190,882, terms net 30, payable Lake Superior Zoo Fund 200, Dept./Agency 130 (Community Resources), and Object 5530 (Improvements Other than Buildings).





STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution simultaneously approves an annual contract with Bedrock Flint, Inc., for tuckpointing and an increase to an existing purchase order for \$190,882.00, payable from the Lake Superior Zoo fund. Tuckpointing is a masonry technique that is used with brick walls, bridges and walkways.

The council was not required to approve the first two purchase orders issued under \$50,000:

The purchasing division posted the original request for bids August 13, 2010, on the city's website, and received two complete local bids by the closing date. Bedrock Flint, Inc., bid the lowest hourly rate. The city awarded a one year contract with two additional one year periods as mutually agreed.

The current project at the zoo is based on a state grant and involves the restoration of five foot bridges and stone assemblies.
