CITY PROPOSAL:



Clyde Industrial Park, Inc. (Clyde Iron Works Restaurant & Bar), 2920 West Michigan Street, for July 13, 2011, from 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.

Hospitality of Duluth, LLC, (Aces of First), 113 West First Street, for July 8, 2011, with music and serving ceasing at midnight. (Rain date July 15, 2011)

Rosberg, Inc. (Roscoe's Pioneer Bar), 323 West First Street, for July 8, 2011, with music and serving ceasing at midnight.

Alcohol, Gambling and Tobacco Commission discussion: 6/1/2011

CLYDE INDUSTRIAL PARK, INC. (CLYDE IRON WORKS RESTAURANT & BAR), 2920 WEST MICHIGAN ST - APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY EXPANSION OF THEIR ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JULY 13, 2011.

Alex Giuliani was present on behalf of the application. He explained that they planning on holding an outdoor concert in the parking lot behind their restaurant on July 13th. Mr. Giuliani continued explaining that there would be only one entrance into the area through the bar and everyone would have a wristband identifying those 21 and older. To questioning from the commission, Officer Vang stated he has talked to the applicant about the number of police officers that would be needed for the event. The clerk stated that the Duluth Heritage stated that the Lincoln Park Business Group has applied for a special events license to block off 29th Avenue West from 6:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. behind their building to allow for overflow of people into the streets. He went on to say that snowfencing will surround the whole perimeter including the avenue and the Post Office will still be able to use their entrance into their building. Mr. Johnson said the music will start at 6:30 p.m. and go to until 10:00 p.m. and they anticipate approximately 1500 people attending the concert. Terry Johnson was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Johnson explained that this request is in conjunction with the street dance sponsored by the Greater Downtown Council as part of Downtown Sidewalk days. He continued saying that special events license closes the street off First Street between First and Second Avenue West in front of their bar, and the street will be closing at 6:00 p.m. and the music and serving will begin at 7:00 p.m. and go until midnight. To questioning from the commission, Officer Vang replied that he will work with the applicant for security for the street dance. There being no further discussion, Mr. Stauber moved that the APPLICATION OF HOSPITALITY ASSOCIATES OF DULUTH, LLC, (ACES ON FIRST) 113 W. ROSSBERG, INC. (ROSCOE'S PIONEER BAR), 323 W. 1ST STREET - APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY EXPANSION OF LICENSED PREMISES OF THEIR ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JULY 8, 2011.

Curt Oberg was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Oberg that this expansion application is for Sidewalk Days. He continued saying that they will be putting a bar out on First Street between 3rd and 4th Avenues which will be blocked off by police barricades. To questioning from the commission, Mr. Oberg replied that there will be a band playing and the serving will start at 7:00 p.m. until midnight. To questioning from the commission, Officer Vang replied that he will work with the applicant for security for the street
