STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes a contract with Duluth Superior Erection, Inc., for the Phase II construction of an accessible baseball field at Harrison Community Center for \$124,504, payable from the general fund. The vendor has done all prior contract work for Phase I.

Phase II costs for this project include i) 14,150 square feet of ballfield surfacing, ii) fencing/backstops/dugouts, and iii) contract overhead. Duluth

Superior Erection's subcontractors include Surface America, Inc., and Century Fence Company.

The purchasing division posted the original invitation to bid April 21, 2011, on the city's website. Duluth Superior Erection, Inc., submitted the only bid by the closing date.
