
CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to accept funds from the United States marshals service (USMS), pursuant to the terms of the Regional Fugitive Task Force Agreement between the USMS and the city of Duluth approved by the city council on August 16, 2010 (contract number 21199), for reimbursement of expenses incurred in support of the regional fugitive task force, said funds to be deposited in Fund 110-160-1610-4209-02 (General Fund, Police Department, Administration and Investigation, Direct Federal Grants Operating).



STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: The Duluth police department has entered into an agreement with the United States Marshals Services (USMS) to participate in the Regional Fugitive Task Force. The mission of the task force is to locate and apprehend persons who have active state and federal warrants for their arrest. The agreement provides that when the USMS receives asset forfeiture funding, it may reimburse organizations participating in the task force for expenses incurred for either overtime, travel, training, equipment or supplies. This resolution authorizes the city to accept such reimbursement funding as it becomes available, which includes \$1,000 at this time.
