
RESOLUTION APPROVING ISSUANCE OF A TEMPORARY ON SALE

Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion of 2/2/2012: Tessa Skajewski was present on behalf of the application. She noted that this is their 25th annual auction that is by invitation only to individuals over 21 years of age. To further questioning, she stated that there will be student workers with adult supervision serving food, but the drinks will only be served from a service bar to the guests. To questioning from the commission, Ms. Skajewski replied that they have hired an off duty police officer to work at the event.
