

CITY PROPOSAL:





STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution renews the city's proprietary annual contract with Polaris Library Systems for the maintenance of the Polaris Integrated Library System in the amount of \$31,168.25, payable from the general fund. This purchase is tax-exempt for the library. The period covered is from March 14, 2012, through March 13, 2012.

Polaris Library Systems (GIS Information Systems, Inc.), headquartered in New York, is the sole supplier of maintenance for the library's automated system. Their mission is to partner with libraries to help them better service their communities.
