
RESOLUTION NAMING FOREST AREAS IN FOND-DU-LAC, MISSION CREEK AND MAGNEY SNIVELY THE MAGNEY-SNIVELY FOREST PRESERVE AND THE FREDERICK RODNEY PAINE FOREST PRESERVE.

BY PRESIDENT HARTMAN:

RESOLVED, that the forest area located between the St. Louis River and Becks Road containing approximately 2,000 acres as delineated on the map on file in the office of the city clerk as Public Document No. \_\_\_\_\_, shall hereafter be referred to as the Frederick Rodney Paine Forest Preserve.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the forest area located to the west of spirit mountain between Becks Rd. and 100<sup>th</sup> Avenue West containing approximately 1,700 acres as delineated on the map on file in the office of the city clerk as Public Document No. \_\_\_\_\_, shall hereafter be referred to as the Magney-Snively Forest Preserve.



STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution names two forest areas located within the city of Duluth the Magney-Snively Forest Preserve and the Frederick Rodney Paine Forest Preserve.

Both of these forest areas have had several common names but were never officially named. Frederick Rodney Paine was appointed by Mayor Snively in 1926 as Superintendent of Parks. As Park Superintendent Frederick Rodney Paine worked to modernize and develop the city park system. Among other endeavors he helped create Leif Erickson Park, Chester Park Bowl, City Nursery at Fond du Lac, Chambers Grove, Memorial Park, Hartley Field, Indian Point Campground, Wheeler Field and the Duluth Heights Playground. Additionally, Frederick Rodney Paine became the first Superintendent of Minnesota Parks and helped create Jay Cooke State Park.

The naming of the Magney-Snively Forest Preserve and the Frederick Rodney Paine Forest Preserve was reviewed and approved by the Parks and Recreation Committee at their meeting on February 8, 2012.

# Fredrick Rodney Paine Forest Preserve


