RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PROPRIETARY CONTRACT WITH NEW WORLD SYSTEMS FOR THE PURCHASE OF SOFTWARE LICENSES AND RELATED IMPLEMENTATION SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$77,946.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to contract with New World Systems for the proprietary purchase of Logos.Net Community Development software and related implementation services, allowing for the replacement of the legacy mainframe licensing application and integration with other critical systems, in accordance with city system specifications and the vendor's quote of \$77,946 (including sales tax), payable as follows:

- (a) \$72,090 from Capital Equipment Fund 250, Administrative Services 015, Fiscal Year 2010, Capital Equipment 5580, Project No. CE250-E1004.
- (b) \$5,856 from General Fund 110, Management Information Services 117, MIS 1107, Computer Supplies/Software 5201.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes a proprietary contract with New World Systems for the purchase of software licenses and related implementation services in the amount of \$77,946 from the capital equipment and general funds.

This purchase will serve as a replacement to the city's legacy mainframe licensing application. This application is critical for the issuance and tracking of the various types of licenses that are handled by the city. This system fully integrates with the city's financial, human resources/payroll, and utility billing systems which will allow for centralized addressing features and seamless real time financial integration. This application will also allow customers online access for license renewals. This project was included as a key project in the city's management information systems business plan.

The city of Duluth has had a contract with New World Systems Corporation since 2004. New World Systems Corporation is located in Troy, Michigan.
