RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE AND DELIVERY OF MOBILE RADIOS AND RELATED ACCESSORIES/EQUIPMENT FOR THE DULUTH FIRE AND POLICE DEPARTMENTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,020,592.14.

CITY PROPOSAL:


RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to contract with Motorola Solutions, Inc., for the purchase and delivery of one-hundred (100) 1250 XTL2500 mobile radios with encryption, twenty-five (25) tax-exempt XTL 2500 mobile radios without encryption for fire apparatus, one-hundred seventy-one (171) XTS 2500 Model II portable radios and accessories with encryption, and ten (10) APX7500 single band control stations and accessories for the Duluth fire and police departments in accordance with Minnesota SWIFT Contract 40071, Release R-651(5) specifications and pricing in the amount of \$959,432.88 plus \$61,159.26 sales tax on the taxable portion of the purchase, for a total combined amount of \$1,020,592.14, terms net 30, FOB destination payable as follows:

- (a) \$260,092.14 from Capital Equipment Fund 250, Dept./Agency 015 (Administrative Services), Div. 2012 (Fiscal Year 2012), Object 5580 (Capital Equipment), Project No. CE250-E1211;
- (b) \$760,500.00 from Duluth Police Grant Programs Fund 215, Dept./Agency 200 (Police), Div. 2204 (2009 Port Security Grant Program), Object 5580 (Capital Equipment).







STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes the purchase and delivery of mobile radios with/without encryption, portable radios and accessories with encryption, and single band control stations and accessories from Motorola Solutions, Inc., for a total of \$1,020,592.14, payable from the Duluth police grant programs and capital equipment funds.

This purchase involves two aspects:

- (a) Necessary first responder emergency communication equipment to comply with federal mandate to migrate public safety radio frequencies to 800 MHz radio (ARMER) system;
- (b) Portable radios for officers and mobile radios for police patrol/emergency response vehicles and supporting communication system infrastructure.

This purchase is based on Minnesota SWIFT contract 40071, Release R-651(5).

Motorola, Inc., has an outlet in Duluth, Minnesota.
