Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion of 5/3/2012:

**COLLEGE OF ST SCHOLASTICA, (JOHN BAGGS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP GOLF TOURNAMENT), 1200 KENWOOD AVENUE** - APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JUNE 9, 2012, WITH KEN KOLQUIST, MANAGER.

Kenny Kolquist was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Kolquist explained that they will be holding a golf tournament and raffle as a fundraiser for a scholarship fund in memory of the baseball coach at St. Scholastica . He continued saying that after the golfing event, there will be a dinner and silent auction in the Reif Center at CSS open to the public and the players starting approximately at 5:00 p.m. and ending approximately 8:00 p.m. To questioning from the commission, Mr. Kolquist replied that they will be having 2-3 off duty police officers working the event that would include checking ID's. He continued saying that they will be using wrist bands to identify underage guests. There being no further discussion, Mr. Birchland moved that THE APPLICATION OF COLLEGE OF ST. SCHOLASTICA, 1200 KENWOOD AVE, FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JUNE 9, 2012, WITH KEN KOLQUIST, MANAGER, BE APPROVED, AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL. Mr. Pekkala seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.

**LAKE SUPERIOR BREWING COMPANY, LLC, (TWIN PORTS BRIDGE FEST), BAYFRONT PARK** - APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JULY 7, 2012, WITH DALE KLEINSCHMIDT, MANAGER.

Don Hoag was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Hoag explained that this is a one day permit for them as a partial sponsor for the Twin Ports Bridge Fest at Bayfront Park which would allow them to serve beer at the event. He stated the entire area will be fenced off in Bayfront with the hours going from noon to 10:00 p.m. He continued explaining that there will be three off duty police officers working the event carding the people and the other two monitoring the two entrances into the fenced in area. To questioning from the commission, Office Vang stated he has been in contact with the promoter and is satisfied with the security arrangements. There being no further discussion, President Donahue moved THAT THE APPLICATION OF LAKE SUPERIOR BREWING COMPANY, LLC, (TWIN PORTS BRIDGE FEST), BAYFRONT PARK, FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JULY 7, 2012, WITH DALE KLEINSCHMIDT, MANAGER, BE APPROVED, AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL.
