Alcohol, Gambling and Tobacco Commission discussion: 5/2/12 Kim Eskola was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Eskola explained that this application is in conjunction with the Far West Celebration on Commonwealth Avenue the weekend of June 22<sup>nd</sup>. He continued saying that these applications would allow him to sell alcohol out on parking lot during the event. He continued saying that the event organizers are applying for a special events license which will close down the streets during the weekend. To questioning from the commission, Officer Vang that security arrangements are being worked on and has approved this application. Attorney Lutterman stated that there was a problem with this application as the corporation that this license would go to is not in good standing with the State. She explained that a license cannot be issued to a corporation that is not active, Mr. Eskola would have to get his corporation status current with the State before the license was issued. Mr. Eskola stated he was not aware of this situation with his corporation, but he would contact the State and get the necessary paperwork down to them. Ms. Lutterman explained the commission could approve this application contingent on the corporation status becoming active. There being no further discussion, Mr. Pekkala moved THAT THE APPLICATION OF ALPINE BAR & LOUNGE, INC., (ALPINE BAR & LOUNGE), 1308 COMMONWEALTH AVENUE FOR TEMPORARY EXPANSION OF LICENSED PREMISES OF THEIR ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JUNE 22-24, 2012, BE APPROVED, SUBJECT TO AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL. Mr. Birchland seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.
