CITY PROPOSAL:


RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to award a contract to Insituform Technologies USA, Inc. for cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) rehabilitation of sanitary sewers in Sewer Basin No. 24 in the amount of \$2,857,975, with \$571,595 payable from Clean Water Fund 532, Department 500 (Public Works & Utilities), Object 5532 (Capital Improvements - Bond), city project no. 0983SN. The remaining \$2,286,380 will be reimbursed with a WIF grant from the PFA.



STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution will authorize award of a contract to Insituform Technologies USA, Inc. in the amount of \$2,857,975 for the cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) rehabilitation of sanitary sewers in Sanitary Sewer Basin No. 24 in the amount of \$2,857,975. Insituform Technologies USA, Inc. was the lowest bidder of the four companies that responded, and their bid is 22 percent below the engineer's estimate of \$3,500,000. We recommend award. Insituform Technologies has performed very well on the last six sewer lining projects. \$571,595 of the contract amount will be payable from Clean Water Fund 532,
