

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution will authorize repairs reconstruction of flood damage to Seventh Avenue East by KTM Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$82,102.71, payable from Disaster Recovery Fund 252, Department 125 (Finance),

Division 1803 (Roads and Bridges), Object 5403 (Street Repair and Maintenance), city project no. 1166, requisition no. 12-0542. KTM Paving, Inc. was the lowest bidder of the three companies that responded. Their bid was 28 per cent lower than the engineer's estimate of \$114,427. We recommend award.
