ARROWHEAD ROAD.


CITY PROPOSAL/COUNCILOR KRAUSE:

WHEREAS, city staff and the Joshua Avenue task force have studied and determined a preferred route for a permanent road in Joshua Avenue from Maple Grove Road to Arrowhead Road, including both residential and rural design street with concrete curb and gutter, bituminous surface, shoulders and storm sewer; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the city council to cause full engineering design, including plans, specifications and environmental approvals, to be completed for the preferred alignment.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Joshua Avenue Route Alternative 4, on file in the office of the city clerk as Public Document No. _____, is hereby approved as the plan for construction of the permanent road and that the city engineer is hereby requested to complete any environmental approvals, and have construction plans and specifications prepared by SEH, Inc. under their existing contract for the construction of said permanent road (City Contract No. 21261) in accordance with the approved route.





STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: The Joshua Avenue Task Force, consisting of residents and business leaders from the Duluth Heights and east end neighborhoods, met several times to discuss and determine a preferred route for the Joshua Avenue extension. This resolution approves the preparation of environmental approvals and full engineering design of the preferred route. This design work will be done under an existing contract with SEH, Inc., funded by a FHWA grant and State Aid funds.
