RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER ONE TO CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT 21763 WITH HUNT ELECTRIC CORPORATION FOR THE INSTALLATION OF NEW TYPE A AND TYPE B LIGHT FIXTURES AT ENGER PARK, AN INCREASE OF \$43,313.00, AND A NEW CONTRACT TOTAL OF \$167,414.00.

CITY PROPOSAL:


RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are authorized to execute Change Order One with Hunt Electric Corporation for the installation of new type A and type B light fixtures at Enger Park, per the original proposal dated September 27, 2012, thereby increasing Contract No. 21763 by \$43,313.00, for a new contract total of \$167,414.00; with the increase of \$43,313.00 payable from the Parks Fund 205, Dept./Agency 130 (Community Resources), Div. 1220 (Parks Capital), Object 5220 (Buildings & Structures), Proj. No. CM205-engtr.



STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes an increase to Contract 21763 with Hunt Electric Corporation for additional work associated with the installation of new Type A and Type B light fixtures at Enger Park for an increase of \$43,313.00, and a total contract amount of \$167,414.00.

The light fixtures were in the vendor's original proposal for electrical upgrades for the entire Enger Park, including wiring the new gazebo. At that time, budgetary constraints prevented the inclusion of the new light fixtures. Since the original contract was approved, additional funds became available to include the light fixtures. (This is shown in plan diagram submitted with this resolution.)

The purchasing division posted the original invitation to bid September 6, 2012, on the city's website, and received two complete bids by the closing date. City staff verified that Hunt Electric Corporation had the lowest bid and proceeded to negotiate cost reductions to stay within budget. The city council approved a contract with passage of Resolution 12-0511R on October 8, 2012.
