

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PROPRIETARY CONTRACT WITH NOVASPECT, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE AND DELIVERY OF TWO (2) FISHER REGULATORS IN YEAR 2013 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$28,903.32.

CITY PROPOSAL:


RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to enter into a proprietary contract with Novaspect, Inc., for the purchase and delivery of two (2) Fisher 1098-EGR regulators, the same brand/model used throughout the Duluth city system, in fiscal year 2013 in the amount of \$27,044.04, and \$1,859.28 sales tax, for a combined total of \$28,903.32, terms net 30, FOB destination, payable from the Gas Fund 520, Dept./Agency 500 (public works and utilities), Org. 1945 (utility operations), Object 5227 (utility systems maintenance supplies).



STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes the proprietary purchase of two (2) brand/model specific Fisher regulators from Novaspect, Inc., for \$28,903.32, payable from the gas fund. The Fisher 1098-EGR regulator is standard equipment throughout the Duluth city system.

The natural gas regulator station at Stora Enso is being redesigned to accommodate a flow meter. As part of the work, two new regulators are being installed commensurate with required re-piping. The regulators removed from this site are to be reused for a system upgrade at regulator station 275.

Novaspect, Inc., is headquartered in Schaumburg, Illinois, with Minnesota outlets in Eden Prairie and Grand Rapids.
