CITY PROPOSAL:


RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to enter into a first amendment to Agreement Number 21736 regarding FY 2012 justice assistance grant between St. Louis County sheriff's office and the city of Duluth, which grant is from the U.S. department of justice and to be used for state and local initiatives with the city of Duluth as the designated recipient and fiscal agent; said first amendment to be substantially in the form of that on file in the office of the city clerk as Public Document No. _____, and reallocates \$7,000 in funding from St. Louis County to the Duluth police department for crime scene investigations equipment, funds to be deposited in Fund No. 215-200-2299-4209-02 (Duluth police grant programs, police, 2012 JAG grant, direct federal grants operating), and expenses to be paid from Fund No. 215-220-2299-5580 (Duluth police grant programs, police, 2012 JAG grant, capital equipment).



STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes the execution of a first amendment to the agreement regarding FY 2012 justice assistance grant between St. Louis County sheriff's office and the city of Duluth. The original agreement was approved by the Duluth City Council on August 27, 2012. This amendment reflects the agreement between the city of Duluth police department and the St. Louis County sheriff's office to reallocate \$7,000 of the grant funding from St. Louis County to the Duluth police department, which reallocated funds are to be used to purchase crime scene investigations (CSI) equipment.

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT REGARDING
FY2012 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT BETWEEN ST. LOUIS COUNTY
SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND THE CITY OF DULUTH**

This Amendment is by and between the City of Duluth ("City") and St. Louis County, a Minnesota county, acting through its Sheriff's Office ("County").

WHEREAS, in October of 2012 the City and County entered into that certain Agreement Regarding FY 2012 Justice Assistant Grant, City contract number 21736, whereby the City, as the recipient of a Justice Assistance Grant from the Bureau of Justice Assistance of the U.S. Department of Justice, agreed to act as fiscal agent for funds to be used to enhance local criminal justice and law enforcement efforts as further described in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement needs to be amended to comply with recent Grantor requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City and County are willing to amend the Agreement as stated below; and

THEREFORE, the City and County agree as follows:

In this Agreement deleted terms will be struck out and the added terms will be underlined.

AMENDMENT 1. That ARTICLE I is amended as follows:

Scope of Professional Services

County agrees to allocate funds that will be used to provide equipment and services in support of state and local initiatives including the First Witness Child Abuse & Resource Center, Southern St. Louis County Drug Court, St. Louis County Mental Health Court and St. Louis County DWI Court, technical assistance, training, personnel, equipment, supplies, contractual support, and criminal justice information systems for criminal justice, as follows:

- \$5,000 to First Witness Child Abuse and Resource Center
- \$5,000 to Southern St. Louis County Drug Court
- \$5,000 to St. Louis County DWI Court

- \$5,000 to St. Louis County Mental Health Court
- ~~\$7,000 to St. Louis County to reimburse for paving the impound lot at the Public Safety Building~~
- \$7,000 to Duluth PD for Crime Scene Investigations (CSI) Equipment

In addition to the above, \$15,370 will be used by the Duluth Police Department to add surveillance cameras to enhance their downtown surveillance camera system.

In the event of any conflict between the terms of the Budget and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of the Budget shall be deemed to be controlling.

Except as amended herein, the terms and conditions of the Agreement and all previous amendments remain in full force and effect.
