
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3) 2013 FORD ECONOLINE E350 CARGO VANS FROM ROSEVILLE MIDWAY FORD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$73,610.56.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to contract with Roseville Midway Ford for the purchase and delivery on three (3) 2013 Ford Econoline 350 cargo vans for public works and utilities in accordance with Minnesota State Contract 35458, Release A-175(5) specifications and pricing in the amount of \$68,777.76, plus \$4,470.55 state motor vehicle tax (6 1/2%), plus \$362.25 license and document fees, for a combined total amount of \$73,610.56, payable as follows:

- (a) \$14,722.11 from Water Fund 510, Dept./Agency 500 (Public Works & Utilities, Div. 1905 (Capital - incl. Depreciation/Debt Service), Obj. 5580 (Capital Equipment));
- (b) \$58,888.45 from Gas Fund 520, Dept./Agency 500 (Public Works & Utilities, Div. 1905 (Capital - incl. Depreciation/Debt Service), Obj. 5580 (Capital Equipment)).



STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes the purchase of three (3) Econoline cargo vans from Midway Ford for public works and utilities in the amount of \$73,610.56, payable from the gas and water funds. Funds were approved from the 2013 capital equipment program. The purchase is based on Minnesota State Contract 35458, Release A-175(5). When the vehicles are approved for purchase, the department will initiate requisitions for standard outfitting of the van interiors with storage cabinets, shelving, and lights.

Historical information: These three new vehicles will replace units 1701, 1702, and 1706.

- (a) Unit 1701 - a 2001 Chevrolet G3500 van with 96,343 miles and 68% of the original purchase price expensed in maintenance and repairs, is to be sold at auction. This vehicle is 12 years old. The estimated cost of major repairs that include electrical problems in the dash panel, engine oil consumption, transmission and rear differential, and rusting wheel wells, side doors and rocker panels are not deemed justifiable for a vehicle of this age and general condition.
- (b) Unit 1702 - a 2001 Chevrolet G3500 van with 112,300 miles and 87% of the original purchase price expensed in maintenance and repairs, is to be sold at auction. Additional expenses for major repairs to the drive train and minor repairs due to body rust are expected if this vehicle is to remain in service.
- (c) Unit 1706 - a 2002 Chevrolet G3500 van with 69,099 miles and 95% of the original purchase price expensed in maintenance and repairs, is to be sold at auction. Additional expenses for major repairs to the transmission and body repairs to the transmission and body repairs due to rusted wheel wells, side doors, and rocker panels are expected if this vehicle is to remain in service.
