
RESOLUTION APPROVING ISSUANCE OF A TEMPORARY ON SALE

Alcohol, Gambling and Tobacco Commission discussion: 5/1/13 Ken Kolquist was present on behalf of the application. He continued saying that they will be using wrist bands to identify underage guests. There being no further discussion, Mr. Birchland moved that THE APPLICATION OF COLLEGE OF ST.
