AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-90 OF THE DULUTH CITY CODE, 1959, AS AMENDED, ADDING ONE ADDITIONAL MEMBER TO DULUTH DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN COMMISSION.

CITY PROPOSAL:

The city of Duluth does ordain:

Section 1. That Section 2-90 of the Duluth City Code, 1959, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-90. City of Duluth deferred compensation plan commission.

A city of Duluth deferred compensation plan commission is hereby established. The commission shall have eight ~~seven~~ members, who shall be appointed by the mayor, but only with the approval of the city council. At least one person from each of the city's collective bargaining units shall be appointed, and any person so appointed shall be qualified to be a member of the commission only while being a member of the collective bargaining unit from which he or she was appointed. The term for any member shall be as the mayor and the city council shall specify at the time of appointment, but no such term shall be for more than four years. Any member or former member may be reappointed.

The duties of the commission shall be:

(a) To monitor the administration of the city of Duluth deferred compensation plan;


(b) To advise the city administration regarding the operation of the plan and the desirability of amending the plan.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its passage and publication.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This ordinance provides a membership spot on the deferred compensation plan commission for the recently established Duluth Police Lieutenants Local 363 bargaining unit, which is represented by Law Enforcement Labor Services (LELS). Various city employees are now represented by six bargaining units instead of five. Pursuant to current Section 2-90, each bargaining unit shall have one representative member on the deferred compensation plan commission board. City administration has two members.
