RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ASTLEFORD INTERNATIONAL TRUCKS FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2014 INTERNATIONAL MODEL 7600 6x4 TANDEM AXLE CAB AND CHASSIS UNITS FOR STREET MAINTENANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$228,134.89.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that city officials are hereby authorized to contract with Astleford International Trucks for the purchase of two (2) 2014 International Model 7600 6x4 tandem axle cab and chassis units for street maintenance in accordance with Minnesota State Contract 61013, Release T-647(5), specifications and pricing for a total of \$213,976.42, plus \$13,908.47 for vehicle sales tax (6 1/2%), plus \$250.00 for license, registration, and tax-exempt plates, for a combined total amount of \$228,134.89, terms net 30, payable from Capital Equipment Fund 250, Dept./Agency 015 (Public Administration), Div. 2013 (Fiscal Year-2013), Object 5580 (Capital Equipment), Project CE250-V1304.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the two International units will be drop-shipped to an outfitter at no expense to the city.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution approves the purchase of two (2) International Model 7600 - 6x4 tandem axle dump truck cab and chassis units for street maintenance in the amount of \$228,134,89, payable from the capital equipment fund. Companion Resolution 13-0358R authorizes the standard outfitting of both vehicles with tandem dump bodies and hoist assemblies.

This purchase is based on Minnesota State Contract 61013, Release T-647(5). The new vehicles will replace two (2) dump trucks - units 1608 and 1613.

Trucks 1608 and 1613 are 1991 Chevrolet Kodiak Class 7 vehicles with high mileage and have been in service with the city for 22 years. They have both far exceeded their original purchase price in maintenance and repairs and are both to be sold at auction. They are being replaced by tandem axle dump trucks, which is a far more efficient use of equipment for hauling large quantities of material and for paving operations for street maintenance. The mileage for Unit 1608 (model year 1991) is 95,741, and the mileage for Unit 1613 (model year 1991) is 74,577.
