

RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are authorized to accept Grant Agreement No. EMW-2012-FP-00272 from the U.S. department of homeland security, federal emergency management agency, assistance to firefighters grant program, fire prevention and safety grant, a copy of which is on file in the office of the city clerk as Public Document No. _____, in the amount of \$9,244, said funds to be deposited in Fund 210-030-3186-4209-02 (special projects, finance, 2012 assistance to firefighters, direct federal grants - operating), for the purpose of purchasing a fire extinguisher simulator, and committing \$2,310 as the city's local share cost of said grant, said sum to be paid from Fund 110-150-1503-5459 (general fund, fire department, life safety division, fire safety education account).



On behalf of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), I am pleased to inform you that your grant application submitted under the FY 2012 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program - Fire Prevention and Safety Grants has been approved.
