
CITY PROPOSAL:

AAD Temple Building Association, (Haunted Hangar on the Hill), 4960 Airport Road, for October 26, 2013, with Ryan Kern, manager.

Alcohol, Gambling and Tobacco Commission discussion: 7/3/13

AAD TEMPLE BUILDING ASSOCIATION, (DULUTH BALLOON FESTIVAL), BAYFRONT PARK - APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE LIQUOR LICENSE FOR SEPTEMBER 20-22, 2013, WITH RYAN KERN, MANAGER.

Devin Graff was present on behalf of the application. Ms. Graff explained that this is new event in Duluth and this is one event with two separate activities going on at the same time. She stated that the Balloon Fest and the Craft Brew Village will be a three day event and attendance will be contingent on the weather. To questioning from the commission, Ms. Graff replied that there will be two areas where alcohol will be served. She explained the one area will be for macro beer and where the food from national concessioners will be served, and then a separate area for just the Craft Brew Village that will be fenced in but not fenced off from the whole event as the whole entire event is fenced off inside Bayfront Park. Ms. Graff stated that after a conversation with Officer Vang, there will be a tent set up where off duty officers will be checking id's and issuing wrist bands for 21+ for the Craft Brew Village section. There being no further discussion, Mr. Stauber moved that THE APPLICATION OF AAD TEMPLE BUILDING ASSOCIATION, (DULUTH BALLOON FESTIVAL), BAYFRONT PARK, FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE LIQUOR LICENSE FOR SEPTEMBER 20-22, 2013, WITH RYAN KERN, MANAGER, BE APPROVED, AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL. AAD TEMPLE BUILDING ASSOCIATION, (HAUNTED HANGER), DULUTH AIRPORT HANGER #3 - APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE LIQUOR LICENSE AND ONE DAY DANCING LICENSE FOR OCTOBER 26, 2013, WITH RYAN KERN, MANAGER.

Devin Graff was present on behalf of the application. Ms. Graff explained that they are having a Halloween party at a hangar at the airport and looking for a temporary liquor license for the event. She continued saying that the event hours are from 9:00 p.m. and ending at 3:00 a.m., with the alcohol serving stopping at 1:00 a.m. and off the tables by 2:00 a.m. She further stated that they will be offering water, soda and food when the sale of alcohol stops. Ms. Graff stated that this year it will be a 21+ event. To questioning from the commission, Ms. Graff replied that masks and face paint won't be allowed so that checking ID's will be easier for security, and that they will have three off duty police working the event and one on call if needed. Officer Vang stated he has approved the application. There being no further discussion, Mr. Rosenthal moved THAT THE APPLICATION OF AAD TEMPLE BUILDING ASSOCIATION, (HAUNTED HANGER), DULUTH AIRPORT HANGER #3 FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE LIQUOR LICENSE AND ONE DAY DANCING LICENSE FOR OCTOBER 26, 2013, WITH RYAN KERN, MANAGER, BE APPROVED, AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL.
