RESOLUTION ORDERING THE IMPROVEMENT OF PLUM STREET FROM NINTH AVENUE EAST TO SKYWOOD LANE BY CITY MAINTENANCE OPERATIONS AT AN ESTIMATED COST OF \$10,000.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that two out of four property owners signed a petition to pave Plum Street from Ninth Avenue East to Skywood Lane, with 72 per cent of frontage signed.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that construction documents were prepared and advertised for public bid. No bids were received.


FURTHER RESOLVED, that continuous erosion of gravel surfaces necessitates excessive maintenance by homeowners and city Maintenance Operations, cleaning eroded material and road bed restoration.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that city Maintenance Operations purchase materials to pave Plum Street by employment of day labor. A detailed account of materials, labor and equipment will be filed with the city clerk.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that assessments shall be levied upon lands benefitting per the preliminary assessment roll and may be paid in five annual installments


at municipal bond index plus 1.50 per cent interest.



STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution will order in assessable improvements of Plum Street from Ninth Avenue East to Skywood Lane by city Maintenance Operations.

As provided for in Section 61 of the City Charter, this process can be commenced either by petition or by action of the city council itself. The former route is being used in this case. A majority of the frontage owners signed a petition requesting this improvement.

Because no bids were submitted for this project, it was decided to request that Maintenance Operations perform the work by employment of day labor.
