RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH BOYER FORD TRUCKS, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2014 WESTERN STAR 4800/4900F CAB/CHASSIS UNIT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$122,041.00 (TO BE EQUIPPED IN 2014 WITH A HYDRO-EXCAVATOR).


CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to contract with Boyer Ford Trucks, Inc., for the purchase and delivery of one (1) 2014 Western Star 4800/4900F cab/chassis unit in accordance with Minnesota State Contract 60992, Release T-647(5) specifications and pricing, for \$114,522.00 plus \$7,519.00 sales tax and tax-exempt plates and registration for a combined total of \$122,041.00, terms net 30, FOB destination, payable as follows:

- (a) \$61,020.50 from Gas Fund 520, Dept./Agency 500 (Public Works & Utilities), Div. 1905 (Capital (incl. deprec./debt svc.), Obj. 5580 (Capital Equipment));
- (b) \$24,408.20 from Water Fund 510, Dept./Agency 500 (Public Works & Utilities), Div. 1905 (Capital (incl. deprec./debt svc.), Obj. 5580 (Capital Equipment));
- (c) \$24,408.20 from Sewer Fund 530, Dept./Agency 500 (Public Works & Utilities), Div. 1905 (Capital (incl. deprec./debt svc.), Obj. 5580 (Capital Equipment)); and
- (d) \$12,204.10 From Stormwater Fund 535, Dept./Agency 500 (Public Works & Utilities), Div. 1905 (Capital (incl. deprec./debt svc.), Obj. 5580 (Capital Equipment)).

Resolved further, this unit will be equipped with a Vactor HXX HydroExcavator upon delivery in 2014.



STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes the purchase of a 2014 Western Star 4800/4900F chassis, to be equipped with a Vactor HXX HydroExcavator upon delivery in 2014. This portion of the equipment request is \$122,041, to be purchased from Boyer Ford Trucks.

This purchase is based on Minnesota State Contract 60992, Release T-647(5). The completed unit will replace Unit 1727. Unit 1727 was purchased in 2002 for \$286,519 and will be 12 years old when replaced. Repair costs currently represent 54% of the original purchase price at \$154,949, with an additional \$30,000 to \$40,000 expected before retiring.

This new unit will be used by all four utilities to perform exploratory operations near buried utilities, thawing and evacuating frozen ground, valve box clean out, as well as utility evacuation.

The complete unit is estimated to cost \$415,000 with a lead time of more than 9 months for delivery. Purchase of the chassis will ensure complete assembly and delivery within 2014. Unit 1727 will be sold in the open market once the new unit is delivered.
