

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

How did the City of Duluth collect and review “salary” data?

Salary data is electronically stored on various payroll systems. The City of Duluth was able to capture annual salary data for current and former City employees for various salary and benefit payment codes as identified in the payroll system. Ineligible salary data was identified by individual and downloaded by calendar year and transmitted to PERA. PERA used this data to recalculate individual retirement benefits and has provided you a summary of these amounts by year.

How do I obtain a copy of my bargaining agreement(s)?

Copies of the bargaining agreements dating back to 1995 can be obtained on the City of Duluth’s website (www.duluthmn.gov), under the Human Resources City Office. If you do not have access to a computer, you may request a copy of the contract by completing a “Request for Information” form and mailing it to the City of Duluth at the following address:
