RESOLUTION AMENDING PROCEDURE FOR SELECTING A CANDIDATE
TO FILL THE VACANCY OF THE SECOND DISTRICT COUNCIL SEAT
OF PATRICK BOYLE.

BY PRESIDENT KRUG:

WHEREAS, the city council adopted Resolution 14-0059, as amended, on January 27, 2014, and established a procedure for selecting a candidate for the vacant Second District council seat previously held by Patrick Boyle; and

WHEREAS, the council effectively narrowed the field of applicants to three candidates: Joel Sipress, Kathy Heltzer, and Angie Miller; and

WHEREAS, the city council has determined that ranked choice voting was not an effective tool for selecting a winner.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the city council hereby amends the procedure for selecting a candidate to fill the vacant Second District council seat as follows:

(a) The top three candidates will be voted on by the council and the candidate receiving a majority vote shall be appointed to the vacant Second District seat;

(b) Successive balloting will be taken until a candidate receives a majority vote;

(c) Should the council president determine that successive balloting is likely to result in no candidate receiving a majority vote, the council president shall open the floor for councilors to re-introduce a candidate from the original pool of applicants for consideration.
